Our history of supporting homeland- and national-security efforts began shortly after NIST--National Bureau of Standards then, as you pointed out-- was founded, in 1901, and continues today with about 100 programs supported by approximately 60 million in direct appropriations, augmented by significant funding support from other agencies, such as the Department of Homeland Security and Department of Justice. Our research is coordinated with the Department of Homeland Security through a Memorandum of Understanding that was signed in May of 2003. Shortly after September 11, 2001, NIST building and fire experts joined teams of scientists and engineers in assessment of how the Pentagon and the World Trade Center buildings were severely damaged or collapsed in the attacks.
