The town is distant eight miles south-west from Warwick, and ninety-four miles north-west from London. The Church stands at its south-eastern extremity, from which it is approached by a paved walk, under an avenue of lime-trees, which have been made to form a complete arcade. This Church was originally a Rectory, in the patronage of the Bishops of Worcester, in whose diocese it is situate; and was purchased in the tenth year of Edward III., anno 1337, of Simon Montacute, the then Bishop, by...
